About the course

Level 2 will suit you if you have some experience in the Hairdressing and Barbering industry. You want to be a **Junior Stylist**.

You will complete between six and nine mandatory units and a range of optional units. Mandatory units include:

- Ensure responsibilities for actions to reduce risks to health & safety
- Advise and consult with clients
- Shampoo and condition and treat hair and scalp
- Cut hair using basic barbering techniques
- Cut facial hair to shape using basic techniques
- Dry and finish man's hair

Optional units include:

- Perming
- Colouring
- Creating patterns
- Promote services
- Develop effectiveness
- Salon reception duties

You will complete these units over a 12 - 24 months, depending on your requirements, within our fully working salon and your place of work.
